The Orange County Rape Crisis Center is dedicated to providing a space for healing for survivors and their loved ones. We serve over 400 clients per year, providing support, resources and information that allow them to heal.

Latino/a Services

All of our services are also provided in Spanish through our Latino/a Services program. We offer bilingual and culturally-competent services to Latinas, Latinos, and other Spanish speakers. These services include our crisis response services, support groups, and community education programs.

Crisis Response Services

Our help line operates 24 hours a day, every day of the year. Anyone can call to ask questions, find more information about services, obtain therapy referrals, or just talk and know someone is really listening. Trained Companions answer the line and are also available to accompany survivors to the hospital, meetings with law enforcement, and court appointments.

Support Groups

The Center offers a variety of support groups throughout the year. We regularly offer groups for Survivors of Rape and Sexual Assault and for Adult Survivors of Child Sexual Abuse. Other groups are offered as needed, such as groups for Spanish-Speaking Survivors and groups for Secondary Survivors (partners and family members of survivors). We also offer alternative groups and workshops such as a running group, arts workshops, nature-oriented groups, and meditation and yoga workshops.
